Sisvel announces new terms and conditions for its DVB-T2 Licensing Program


Stuttgart, 26 January 2018 – Sisvel Germany announced today that the terms and conditions of its DVB-T2 Licensing Program have been revised to comprise new categories of licensed products. Sisvel's DVB-T2 program offers a license to essential patents owned by British Broadcasting Corporation (BBC), DTVG Licensing, Electronics and Telecommunications Research Institute (ETRI), Fraunhofer-Gesellschaft zur Förderung der angewandten Forschung e.V., RAI – Radiotelevisione Italiana S.p.A, TDF S.A.S. and IMT Atlantique (ex Telecom Bretagne and member of IMT: Institut Mines Telecom ex GET).

The licensing program, previously limited to consumer decoder products, has now been extended to cover both professional and consumer products which comprise either or both

- a DVB-T2 transmitting, encoding or modulating functionality ("Encoder function") and/or;
- a DVB-T2 receiving, decoding or demodulating functionality ("Decoder function")

The Patent Owners have agreed on a Standard Royalty Rate for each category of the licensed products as per the central column of the table below. However, provided that the licensee is in full compliance with its obligations under the license agreement, then the royalty rate payable in respect of each Licensed Product shall be calculated under the Royalty Rate for compliant licensees as per the last column of the table below.

Licensed Professional Product with one of Encoder or Decoder function	€ 18.00 (eighteen Euros)	€15.00 (fifteen Euros)
Licensed Professional Product with both Encoder and Decoder functions	€ 24.00 (twenty-four Euros)	€20.00 (twenty Euros)

The Digital Video Broadcasting – Terrestrial 2 ("DVB-T2") is the most advanced standard for broadcasting digital television on terrestrial networks, offering a substantial increase in transmission capacity compared to DVB-T.
